1. Frank Hjalmar² Carlson (Carl Oscar¹ Johnson) was born July 08, 1856 in Hammer, Ostergotland, Sweden, and died March 05, 1930 in Alvarado (Marshall County), Minnesota. He married **Mary Vislander Noren** December 21, 1886 in Hallock (Kittson County), Minnesota, daughter of Carl Noreen and Johanna Engstrom. She was born September 12, 1856 in Prosto-Nyble Smaland, Sweden, and died March 02, 1924 in Lancaster (Kittson County), Minnesota.

Notes for Frank Hjalmar Carlson:

Frank was born in Hammer, Ostergotland, Sweden and confirmed in the Swedish State Church in 1871. Mr. Carlson came to America in 1881 settling first in Wisconsin and later coming to these parts in 1885. He lived on his farm at Lancaster until 1925 when he moved to Alvarado where he made his home with his son, Albin Carlson, until his death.

Frank Carlson came to Kittson County from Wisconsin in 1885. The land was surveyed and opened for homesteading which meant you could file on a quarter section of land and improved it under their qualifications, which he did on Kittson County in the township of Granville.

In 1886, he was married to Mary Noreen and settled on their homestead. They started to improve their surroundings-cutting grass, brush and trees. They faced many hardships, long and tedious hours of work to get the land ready to produce a crop. At that time there were no power machines-no power except horses and walking plows. This meant you had to walk and hold onto a pair of shafts from one end of the field to the other.

To get some material for a building, Frank spent part of one winter hauling tamarac logs from Roseau County. It was a three day trip with team and sleigh. The logs were to be used for frame work for a granary and machine shed. On some occasions the weather was nice when he left but before he got back home it could come up a snowstorm. When he was gone Mother and the older boys took care of the stock which consisted of milk cows, chickens and pigs. The building was erected the following year.

In 1903 and 1904, a thirty foot square excavation was made for the basement of their new home. As there was no machinery for that purpose horses and scraper were used. The walls and partitions were made of stone gathered around the farm. The building of the foundation for the house was done by stone masons. In 1905 the house was built. When it was finished, the old building was demolished or dismantled as it was built of logs. It was rebuilt as a shop. As the new building was ready for the roof, roof boards were put on. Frank stepped on a board that wasn't nailed and fell to the ground. He got a bad shakeup. As time went on the building was finished. As the boys grew up, Frank acquired more land and newer equipment. He semi-retired and did odd jobs around the farm.

Mr. and Mrs. Carlson were active and faithful members of the Saron Lutheran Church and willing to respond with their help when needed. They retired and purchased a house in Lancaster where they lived for a few years. Mrs. Carlson passed away after a short illness and was buried in the family plot in the Saron Cemetery. Mr. Carlson moved back to the farm and stayed with his son Albin and family until the fall of 1925. They moved to Alvarado, Minnesota, where Albin had purchased a farm. He stayed there with his son until 1929 when he passed away. He was brought to his home church for burial and was laid to rest beside his wife in the Saron Cemetery.

Notes for Mary Vislander Noren:

Ingrid came to America in 1870 and made her first home in St. Paul. In 1876, she came to Hallock.

Mr. and Mrs. Carlson made their home in Granville township until September 1922 when they retired and moved to Lancaster where they lived since.

The funeral services were held at the home at 1:00 p.m. and at the Saron Church at 2:00 p.m. on Wednesday March 5th. Interment was made at the Saron cemetery. Rev. J. B. Sorenson of Lancaster officiated. Mrs. Carlson has been a member of the Saron church since 1893.

C. at Crookston where he attended a trade school, studies related to construction work, plans, etc. He was baptized and confirmed in the Lutheran faith and in his early years attended Saron Lutheran Church near his farm home. He was a member of the Hallock Lions Club and also the G. A. Leonard Norberg Post of the American Legion in Hallock. He served in the armed forces in World War II. His hobbies were fishing and camping and we believe he played some golf.

Mr. Carlson spent his early life on the farm of his parents. After he grew to manhood, he became a carpenter, also did contracting work in the building trade. He was an exceptionally talented person and could handle any part of building work.

Walter Carlson Missing ...

Walt Carlson, one of Hallock's best known citizens is believed to have drowned in the waters of the Rainy River a short distance above the mouth of that stream where it empties into Lake of the Woods.

Walter Carlson's Body Found, Rites Monday ...

Walter F. Carlson, well known local carpenter and contractor died Saturday while on a fishing trip to Lake of the Woods. He and his usual fishing pals had gone to Adrian's Resort where they always make reservations. Walter was fishing in the rain from the dock below the resort. The dock was wet and slippery. In some way or other, he slipped on the dock and fell into the river. Walter was unable to swim.

His body was recovered Sunday, May 27th, 12 days after he drowned, by two Hallock men.

The funeral was held Monday at 2:00 p.m. at Grace Lutheran Church, Hallock. Two clergymen officiated. Rev. Youngdale of the local church and also Rev. Carroll Anderson of Saron Lutheran which was his home church. Burial was at Greenwood Cemetery in Hallock.

The pallbearers were selected by the local Legion Post and military rites were conducted.

Notes for Henry Arthur Carlson:

Henry was baptized and confirmed in the Lutheran faith, a member of Grace Lutheran Church in Hallock and formerly a member of Saron Lutheran Church, serving on the church board. He also served on the telephone board, school board, and a member of the Farmers Union.

When Henry was old enough to go to school, he and his brother Albin walked three miles to the north Granville school, where only spring and fall terms were held. It was a long walk for a 6 1/2 and an 8 year old child. Later on a school was built in South Granville which was much closer. This school building was struck by lightning and was totally destroyed. A new school was built in 1908.

Sometimes in the busy season, Henry carried butter, which his mother had made, to Hallock. This was sold for 7 cents a pound and exchanged for groceries. As Henry grew older, he got jobs doing chores for people who needed help and also did some field work. Later Henry got on a carpenter's crew - that was quite an experience in the building trade. Various homes were built by this crew and also the Sion Lutheran Church in Lancaster. After the Saron church was struck by lightning and burned, the crew got the contract to rebuild it. Henry worked with an elevator crew for one season - working at Hallock, Eagle Bend and Hewitt, Minnesota.

In the fall of 1916, Henry went to Saskatchewan, Canada to work during the harvest season. From there he went to Alberta to visit his cousins. They farmed quite extensively and had a large cattle ranch. In the spring there was vaccination and branding before the cattle were turned out to pasture. Later, he worked on a horse ranch were the animals were broken and trained for work and later sold. One pinned him against the manger and broke his collar bone. He was laid up for a while until it healed.

Henry left for home in the fall of 1923. Then as winter approached, he worked with his brother (Albin) in log cutting and hauling packing ice at Lake Bronson. Early winter in 1924, two fellows went with Henry to look for work in a logging camp. When they arrived at Gimmell, Minnesota, Henry went to the office and asked for work in the kitchen. So, he was busy peeling potatoes, washing dishes, etc. When the second cook was laid off, Henry was asked to take over. He had had some experience in cooking but nothing as big as this. There were four men in the kitchen - the chef, second cook and two helpers. There were about 125 laborers, more or less, to feed.

Henry's brother (Albin) and family moved from the home farm to Alvarado in the fall of 1925. It was time for Henry to leave the suitcase and settle down. Henry rented the home farm from his father.

Henry bought the home farm from the Carlson estate in 1944. Some years were good and others not so good. One year the rust and heat destroyed the wheat-it didn't even make chicken feed so they burned the crop. For several years, they boarded the teachers who taught in the South Granville school.

In semiretirement, Henry and Christine were into rug weaving as a hobby. They were life-long members of the Saron Lutheran church until it was dissolved.

Funeral services were held on March 15 at the Grace Lutheran in Hallock with Rev. Kenneth Losch officiating. Music for the services was provided by Frances Pearson, soloist, and Alice Pearson, organist.
